

MITCHELL ROBLES

Mitchell Robles is highly regarded for his unique blend of abstract expressionism and contemporary Native American art. A native of Santa Barbara, California, he is a direct descendent of the indigenous Chumash peoples and the earliest Spanish settlers. Robles' paintings reflect a deep connection to his ancient lineage, and to the natural world.

Influenced by Fritz Scholder, John Nieto, and Peter Max, Robles' oil, acrylic and mixed media canvases explode with vibrant colors and luxuriously layered textures. Powerful echoes of his ancestry are revealed in majestic images of wildlife against bold backgrounds, mysterious abstract landscapes, and highly stylized and sculpted ceremonial warshirts. The cattle in his Texas Longhorn Series project a profoundly masculine soulfulness. The colorful petroglyphs in his Rock Art Series come alive with a playful mysticism that entices the viewer into a magical dreamworld.

Robles' work is exhibited in galleries throughout California and in Scottsdale, Sedona, Santa Fe, and Jackson Hole. His art has been featured in numerous publications and several Sundance Film Festival documentaries.
